CDBG PROGRAM GOALS:

Develop viable urban communities principally to benefit low- and moderate-income residents and neighborhoods

2023 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- ❑ **Preserve Affordable Housing** – DevNW completed 2 housing rehab loan projects and 6 were started and will be completed in the 2023-2024 program year.
- ❑ **Create Affordable Housing Opportunities** – Creating Housing Coalition constructed 27 affordable housing units.



2023 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

❑ Child Care Services:

- The YMCA provided 21 childcare scholarships for children from low- and moderate-income families
- The Boys and Girls Club provided 108 scholarships for Albany youth from low- and moderate-income families to access after school and summer childcare.

❑ **Senior Companion Program** – Oregon Cascades West Council of Governments ensured 13 low-income seniors received services from companions

❑ **Emergency Motel Stays** – Center Against Rape Domestic Violence served 21 individuals seeking safety from abusive relationships .

❑ Reduce Homelessness:

- Jackson Street Youth Services provided shelter and case management for 61 youth at the Albany House.
- COAT provided outreach and resource connection to 921 unsheltered residents and case management to 41 residents experiencing homelessness

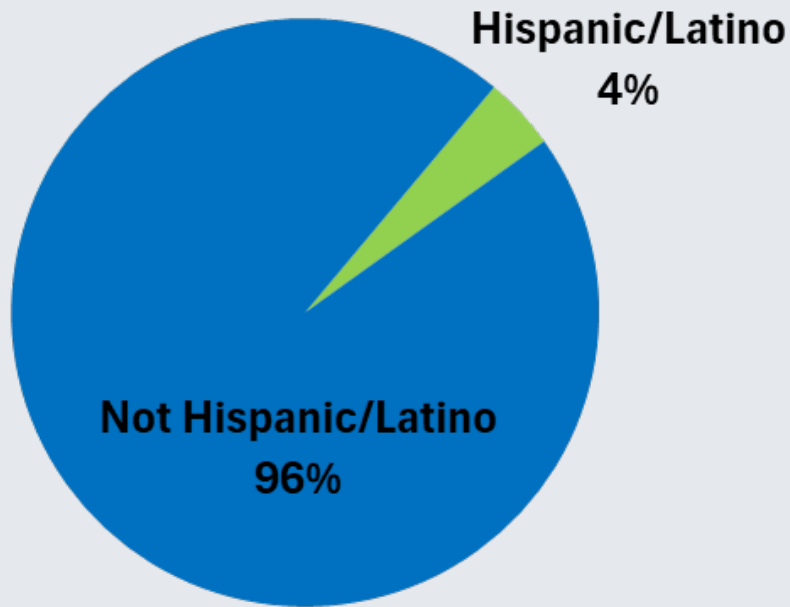
2023 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- ❑ **Lehigh Park Improvements** – New playground equipment was purchased in program year 2023 and will be installed in program year 2024.

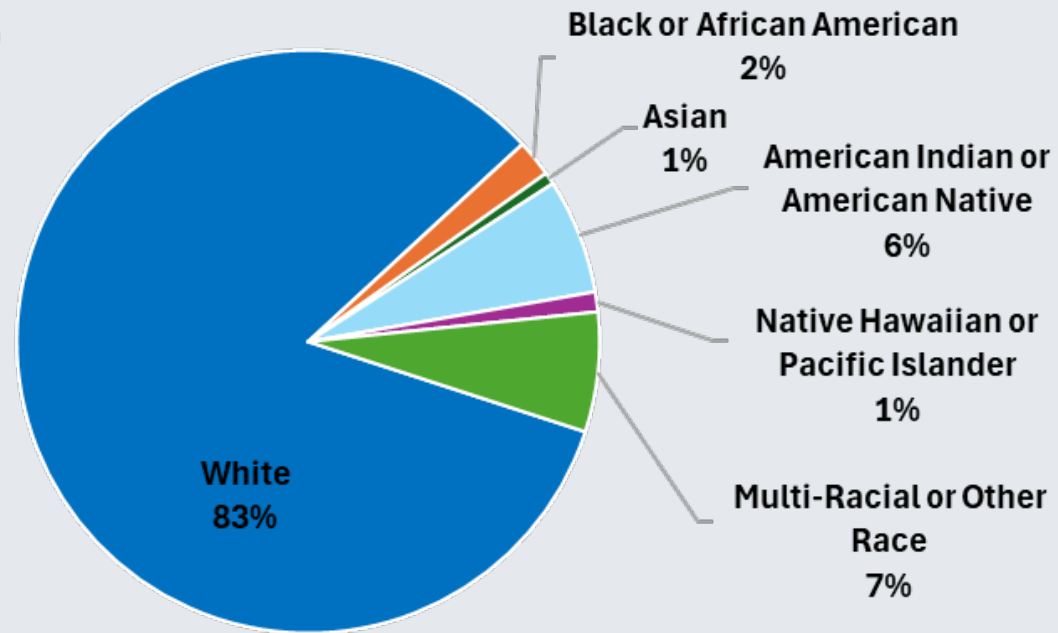


2023 DEMOGRAPHICS
