PUBLIC NOTICE OF SOLE-SOURCE PROCUREMENT

Notice is hereby given that the City of Albany intends to enter into a sole-source contract in accordance with OAR 137-047-0275 with American Traffic Solutions, Inc., DBA Verra Mobility, for approximately \$504,000 per year for a photo red light enforcement program and photo speed enforcement at four intersections.

Verra Mobility is the sole provider of the operating system that is compatible with the photo enforcement system currently in place and required for continued use of the photo red light enforcement system and the addition of a photo speed enforcement system. The use of a Sole-source Procurement is necessary in order to continue using internal processes and programs for efficient utilization of the existing software and equipment through a contract with Verra Mobility, rather than replace established infrastructure and systems.

The purpose of this notice is to provide information to the public and to invite interested persons an opportunity to submit written comment within seven days of the date of this public notice. The protest shall provide a detailed statement of the legal and factual grounds for the protest, a description of the resulting harm to the Affected Person, and the relief requested.

Written protests must be delivered to Diane Murzynski, Contracts & Procurement Officer, in the Finance Department of the City of Albany no later than 12:00 p.m., Wednesday, December 27, 2023. Written protests received after the closing date and time are late and will not be considered. Protests must be submitted by email to procurement@cityofalbany.net.

This notice is given in accordance with provisions of the Albany Municipal Code, Section 2.66.060(11); Oregon Revised Statutes, 279B.075; and Oregon Administrative Rules, 137-047-0275.
