- Three (3) stationary and one (1) remote/mobile IP radio dispatch consoles
- Eight (8) (minimum) radio resources per console
- Scalable P25 architecture capable of integrating with a conventional analog radio system and a remote core trunked radio system
- Radio console interface to the City's Cisco Unified CM Phone System, and Stancil SLR logging recorder
- A system that can upgrade equipment in a structured manner as new technologies emerge, avoiding major equipment replacement
