SS-17-01, Cox Creek Interceptor Improvements: Phase 1

In order to clarify the intent of the Specifications and Drawings, the following provisions are provided and shall be considered part of the contract documents.

In order to ensure that all bidders are aware of these provisions, each bidder shall sign this addendum below and attach it to the proposal.

IMPORTANT: Failure to include a signed Addendum could result in the disqualification of your bid.

Correction to Addendum #1's second bullet point under the GENERAL section;

- The overhead wire running parallel along the northern railroad property line is a communication line, not overhead power lines. The communication line is believed to be owned by CenturyLink. The Contractor shall be responsible for all costs associated with coordinating with CenturyLink as necessary to protect and work around the line during construction.

Correction to Invitation to Bid due date;

- Bids submitted shall be filed in sealed envelopes and received at the City of Albany Parks & Recreation counter, not later than 2:30 p.m., Tuesday, **May 7, 2019**, addressed to the attention of Diane Murzynski, Purchasing Coordinator, at Albany City Hall, Finance Department, 333 Broadalbin Street SW, Albany, OR 97321. The outside of the envelopes shall plainly identify: (1) the Project name, (2) the Bid Opening time and date, (3) the Bidder's name, and (4) the Contractor's license number (per ORS 701). Immediately following the filing deadline, the bids shall be opened and publicly read in the Santiam Room of City Hall. The City of Albany hereby extends an invitation to submit bids for:

SS-17-01, Cox Creek Interceptor Improvements: Phase 1: This project includes open trench installation of approximately 2,400 feet of 24-inch and 30-inch sanitary sewer main at an average depth of approximately 25 feet; 450 feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer main; and related appurtenances. This project also includes two jack and bore locations totaling an installation of approximately 240 feet of 48-inch steel casing.

Bids submitted shall be filed in sealed envelopes and received at the City of Albany Parks & Recreation counter, not later than 2:30 p.m., Tuesday, ~~April 22~~ **May 7**, 2019, addressed to the attention of Diane Murzynski, Purchasing Coordinator, at Albany City Hall, Finance Department, 333 Broadalbin Street SW, Albany, OR 97321. The outside of the envelopes shall plainly identify: (1) the Project name, (2) the Bid Opening time and date, (3) the Bidder's name, and (4) the Contractor's license number (per ORS 701). Immediately following the filing deadline, the bids shall be opened and publicly read in the Santiam Room of City Hall. Each bidder must have access to a current set of City of Albany *Standard Construction Specifications*, which can be found on the City's website at <http://www.cityofalbany.net/departments/public-works/engineering/standard-construction-specifications> or a printed set may be purchased for \$100. All public improvements are required to conform to these specifications and bid prices shall reflect these specifications. For project information, call Lori Schumacher at 541-917-7653.

All City contracts contain a statement declaring that the bidder agrees to comply with the provisions of ORS 279C.800 through 279C.870 regarding payment of prevailing wages. The City's contract contains a clause which incorporates by reference all of the provisions of ORS Chapter 279C, which are applicable to public contracts. Bidders are expected to be familiar with these provisions including, but not limited to, recent changes to ORS Chapter 279C.

No bid shall be received or considered unless the bidder is licensed by the Construction Contractors Board for construction projects or licensed with the State Landscape Contractors Board for landscaping projects.

A 10% bid bond, certified check, or cashier's check shall accompany each bid on all projects and shall be forfeited if the bidder fails to enter into a Contract with the City of Albany within ten (10) days after the date of the Notice of Award.
