working hours required to complete cured-in-place pipe liner installation. The Contractor shall provide a minimum of 72 hours advanced notice of any work that will occur outside of normal working hours.

Item No. A-12 and B-11: Manhole Rehabilitation: Add the following text to these two bid items.

There are no known existing coatings in manholes to be rehabilitated with this item. If existing coatings are discovered during construction, they shall be removed or prepared as required per the specifications. Any additional work required to remove or prepare existing coatings shall be paid for by change order.
